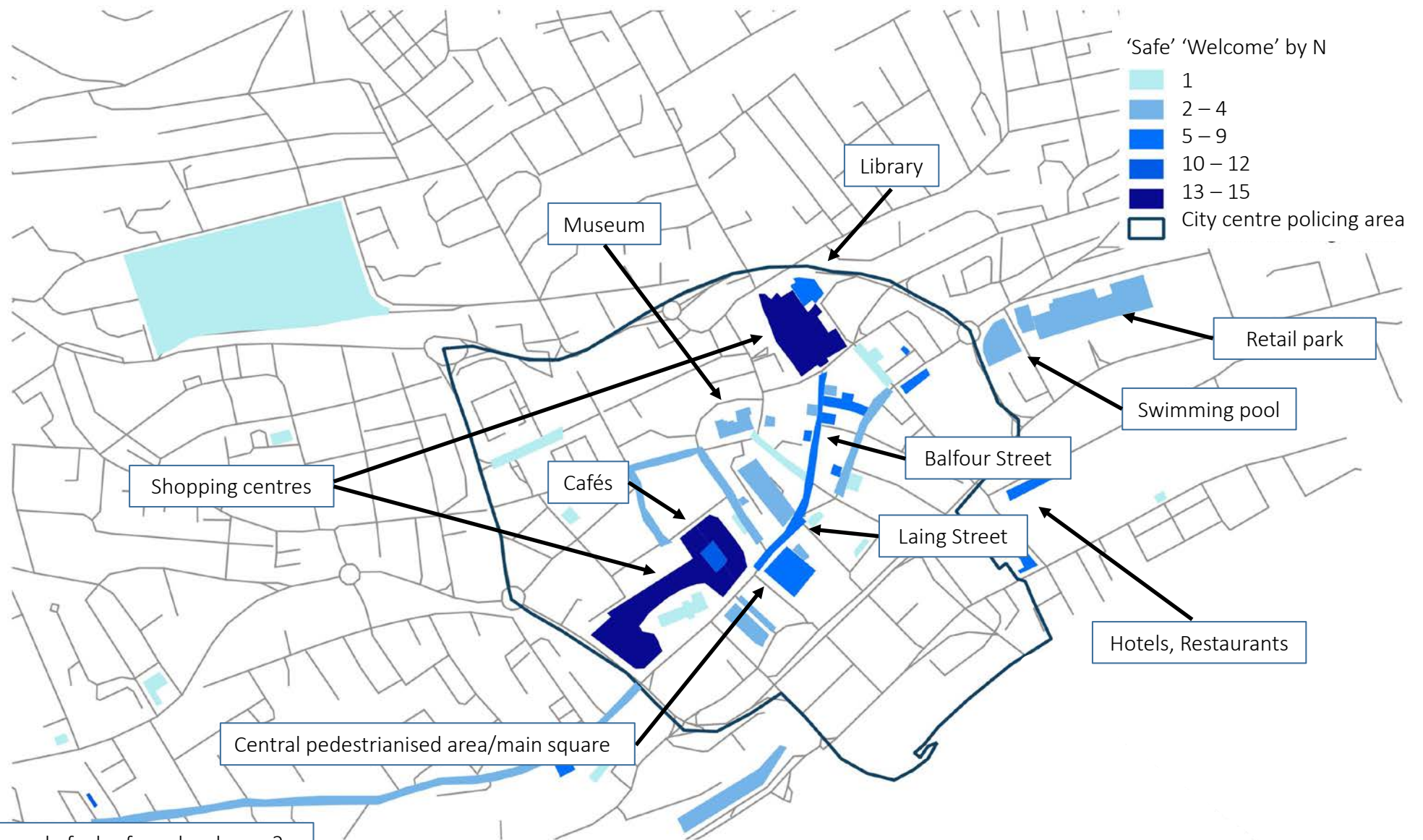


Fig.3: Where do people feel safe and welcome?
