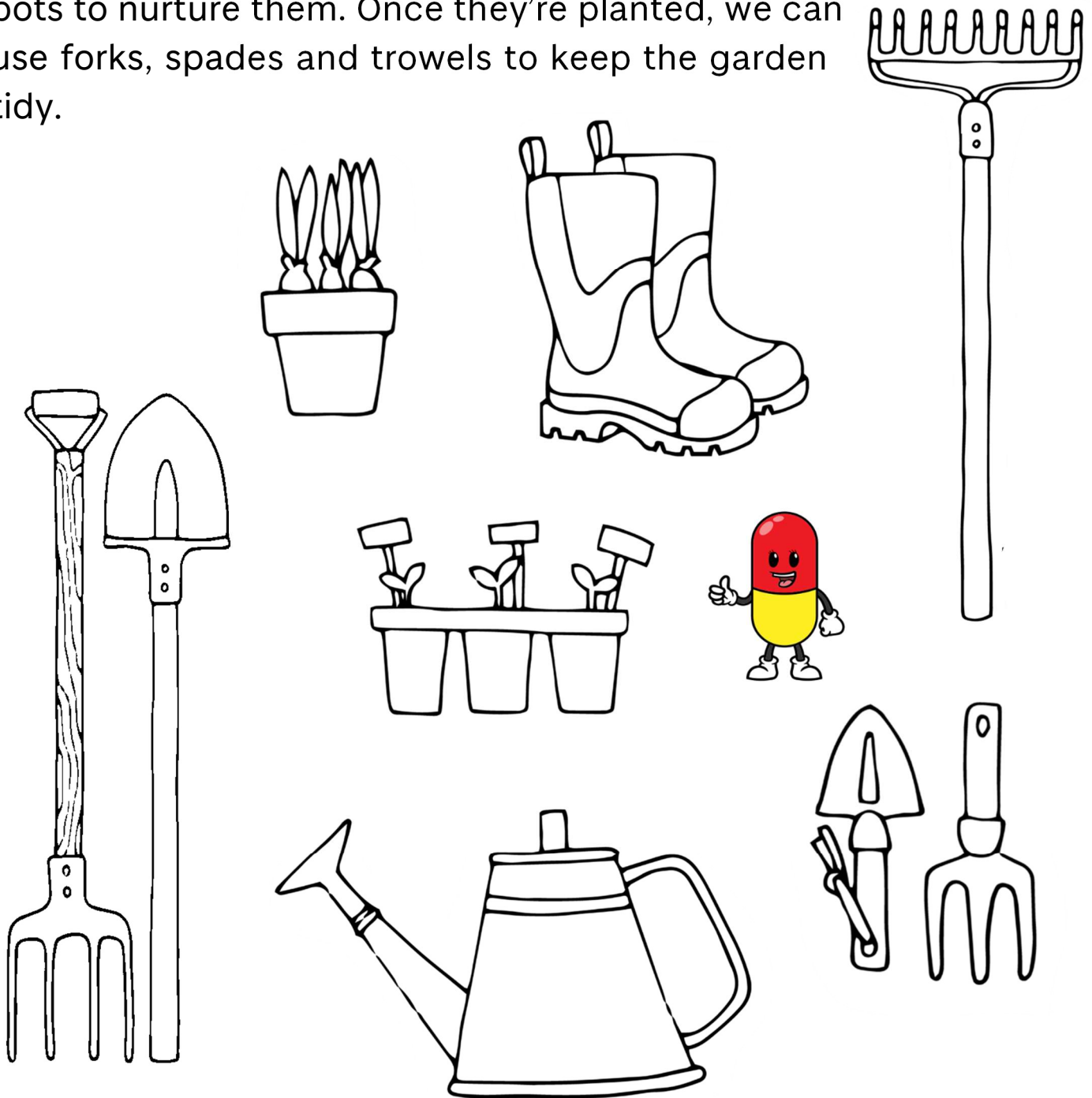

To keep plants healthy we have to use lots of different tools. We wear welly boots to keep our feet clean and safe whilst working in the garden.

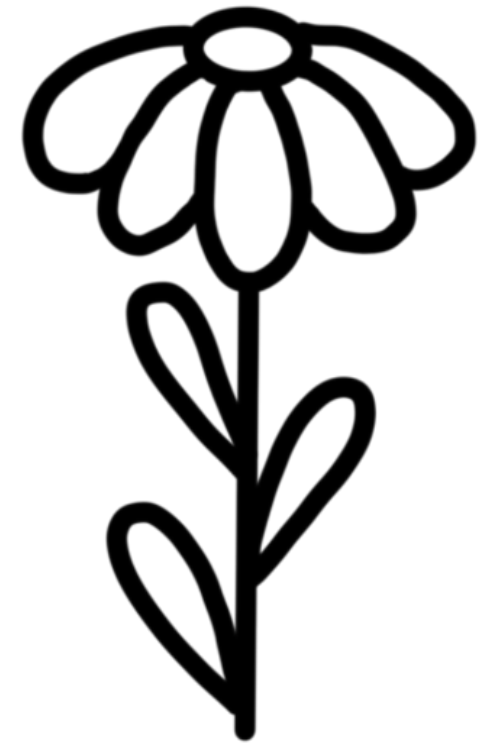
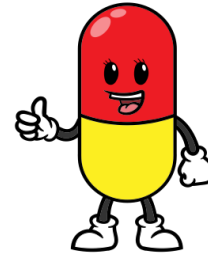
Before we put our plants into the ground we grow them in small pots to nurture them. Once they're planted, we can use forks, spades and trowels to keep the garden tidy.

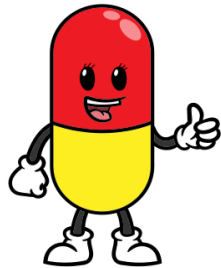
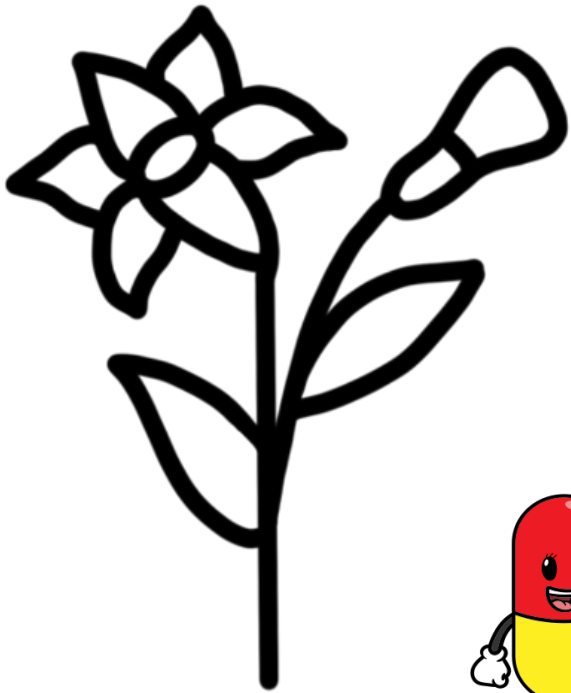
