On 6-18 November, the Conference of the Parties (COP) of the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP 27) will meet in [Sharm el-Sheikh Climate Change Conference - November 2022 | UNFCCC](#) to build on efforts to reduce carbon emissions and progress on the just transition to net-zero economies. What is at stake in COP 27? What are the debates and challenges on the just transitions in global and regional agendas?
